

What to wear at the Ranch:

SUN SCREEN: PROTECT YOURSELF. BALL CAP IS ALSO HELPFUL WHEN WE ARE OUTSIDE AND NOT ON THE HORSE.

HELMET: WE DO HAVE HELMETS (FOR MOST SIZES) FOR YOUR FIRST FEW LESSONS. AFTER YOUR INTRODUCTORY LESSONS, WE ASK THAT YOU PURCHASE YOUR OWN HELMET IF POSSIBLE.

LONG PANTS: LONG PANTS DOWN TO YOUR SHOES. NO CAPRIS OR SHORTS.

PLEASE NO TACKS, BLING-BLING OR BRADS ON YOUR BACK POCKETS THAT COULD SCRATCH THE SADDLES.

SHOES: SHOES SHOULD BE HARD SHOES JUST IN CASE A HORSE HOOF STEPS ON YOUR FOOT. YOU WANT TO PROTECT YOUR TOES.

SHIRTS: SHIRTS WITH SLEEVES OR TANK TOPS FINE. PLEASE NO SPAGHETTI STRAPS. SHIRTS NEED TO BE LONG ENOUGH TO COVER YOUR BELT-LINE WHEN YOU'RE BENT OVER. WE DO HAVE SOME GREAT BARN SHIRTS FOR SALE FOR \$15.00 EACH.
